AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUMSON
BY AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rumson, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter VI, Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 6-3, Licenses, § 6-3.4, License Fees; Maximum Number, be amended to read as follows:

6-3.4 License Fees: Maximum Number.

From and after the effective date hereof the annual fees and maximum number of licenses for the sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages in the Borough shall be as follows:

Class of License	Annual License Fee		Number of Licenses
Plenary Retail Consumption License	\$1,491.00	<u>\$1,789.00</u>	9
Plenary Retail Distribution License	\$ 817.00	<u>\$ 980.00</u>	2

The provisions of this subsection with respect to the limitation on the number of licenses shall not apply to the renewal or transfer or licenses presently issued.

SECTION 4. That Chapter VI, Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 6-4, Regulation of Licenses, § 6-4.2 Sundays, to be amended as follows:

6-4.2 Sundays.

The provisions of subsection 6-4.1 shall not apply on Sundays. On Sundays, no alcoholic beverage shall be sold, served, delivered to or consumed in the licensed premises between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and ~~12:00 noon~~ 11:00 a.m.

SECTION 3. That Chapter VI, Alcoholic Beverage Control, Section 6-5, Borough Alcoholic Beverage Service Permits, § 6-5.4, Issuance of Borough Alcoholic Beverage Service ID Cards to Applicants, be amended as follows:

6-5.4 Issuance of Borough Alcoholic Beverage Service ID Cards to Applicants.

a. through c. No Change.

d. The requirement for the Borough alcoholic beverage service permit for all servers shall be put in place on ~~July 1, 2009~~ January 1, 2010. All servers must complete the process and have their ID cards prior to the renewal of the establishments' liquor license on July 1, 2010.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon the passage and publication according to law.
